

Nathan Treff is the Chief Scientific Officer at Genomic Prediction, and has a long history in reproductive genetic testing. He is adjunct faculty at Rutgers University School of Medicine, where he teaches reproductive genetics. Nathan is the recipient of 2 General Program, 2 SART, and 2 SRBT Prize Paper Awards, and the 2013 New Investigator Award from ASRM. He has published over 90 peer reviewed papers in Reproductive Genetics and serves as a member of the ASRM Research Committee, and Senior Associate Editor of JARG, and Editor of Fertility and Sterility. He holds a PhD in Biochemistry from Washington State University, and the HCLD certification in Molecular Diagnostics from the American Board of Bioanalysis (ABB). He was also the Director of Molecular Biology at Reproductive Medicine Associates of New Jersey for 11 years.
