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The postnatal outcome of children born after PGT

Since the first in-vitro fertilization (IVF) birth, the number of assisted reproductive technology (ART) treatments has been steadily increasing worldwide. With the advancement of technology, additional procedures such as preimplantation genetic testing (PGT) were introduced. One of the main concerns is the possible increased risk for adverse outcomes to children born following ART treatments in general and PGT in particular. The literature regarding the post neonatal outcomes of children born following these procedures as compared to spontaneously-conceived children will be presented.
