Dr. Zaher Merhi earned both his Bachelor of Science degree in Biology and his medical degree from the American University of Beirut in Lebanon. He completed his residency in Obstetrics and Gynecology at Maimonides Medical Center in Brooklyn, New York. This was followed by a two-year Postdoctoral Fellowship in Reproductive Endocrinology at Albert Einstein College of Medicine in Bronx, New York. Subsequently, he completed a three-year Clinical Fellowship in Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility at Albert Einstein College of Medicine/Montefiore Medical Center in Bronx, New York.

Board-certified in Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility by the American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology, Dr. Merhi was an Assistant Professor in Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility at the University of Vermont College of Medicine in Burlington and most recently, an Assistant Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology and Reproductive Biology at NYU School of Medicine in New York City.

As an active researcher and honoree of many awards, Dr. Merhi has published over 60 manuscripts in respected medical journals such as *Journal of Clinical Endocrinology and Metabolism*, *Fertility and Sterility*, and *Human Reproduction*, as well as many book chapters.
