

Grigoris T Gerotziapas is Associate Professor of Hematology at the Faculté de Médecine, Sorbonne Université and leads the research group "Cancer Hemostasis and Angiogenesis" in INSERM UMRS-938 and the Clinical Haemostasis Group at the Service d'Hématologie Clinique et Thérapie Cellulaire, AP-HP.6, Hôpital Saint-Antoine, Paris, France.

His fundamental research is focused on the interactions between cancer cells and blood coagulation and the mechanism of action of antithrombotic drugs in cancer. His group is active in translational research in the development of risk assessment models for venous thromboembolism in patients with multiple myeloma or solide tumors.
