

Short biography:

Prof Dr med Ernst Holler was trained in hematology and stem cell transplantation at the Ludwig-Maximilians University München. Since 1998, he is the director of the clinical and experimental allogeneic stem cell transplant program at the Department of Internal Medicine 3, University of Regensburg, Germany. His translational research program focusses on the pathophysiology of acute graft-versus host disease and he has published more than 250 peer reviewed manuscripts around GvHD. Major current research interests are the integration of the MAGIC GvHD biomarkers in daily clinical practice of GvHD diagnosis and treatment as well as the role of microbiota in the pathophysiology of HSCT related complications
