Robert J. Soiffer, MD, is Chair of the Executive Committee for Clinical Programs, Chief of the Division of Hematologic Malignancies, and Vice Chair of the Department of Medical Oncology at Dana-Farber Cancer Institute. He is Co-director of the Adult Hematopoietic Transplant Program at Dana-Farber/Brigham and Women's Hospital and a Professor of Medicine at Harvard Medical School.

Dr. Soiffer's research focuses on modulation of immune responses in the setting of hematopoietic stem cell transplantation. The ultimate goal for his clinical trials and research grants is to optimize graft versus leukemia activity without inducing graft versus host disease.

Dr. Soiffer is a former President of the American Society for Blood and Marrow Transplantation. He chairs the Advisory Board for the Center for International Blood and Marrow Transplant Research, and serves on the Executive Steering Committees for Blood and Marrow Transplant Clinical Trials Network. Dr. Soiffer is on the Board of Directors for the National Marrow Donor Program. He has co-authored more than 300 peer-reviewed manuscripts and numerous book chapters, review articles, editorials, and monographs. He has served on the Editorial Boards of multiple journals.

Dr. Soiffer has received several honors and awards including the Casty Family Achievement in Mentoring Award from Dana-Farber, the Brian O'Dell Memorial Research Award from the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society, the Lee M. Nadler "Extra Mile" Award from Dana-Farber, and the George Thorn Award for Outstanding Teaching at Brigham and Women's Hospital.
