Dr. Antoni Borrell's interest is in the field of Fetal Medicine, particularly Prenatal Diagnosis and Screening of congenital anomalies, Fetal Ultrasound and Reproductive Genetics. An area of expertise is the ultrasound recognition of fetal syndromes, another is in prenatal genetic diagnosis and screening. Board certificated in Obstetrics and Gynecology, he was trained in Fetal Medicine at Queen Charlotte's and Chelsea Hospital of London, and he has been on sabbatical studies at the Karolinska Institute Hospital, Stockholm, at Brigham & Women's Hospital, a Harvard Medical School affiliated hospital, and at Mount Sinai Hospital Toronto. He is Senior Consultant in Fetal Medicine at Hospital Clinic Barcelona, director of the prenatal diagnosis programme, and associated professor of the University of Barcelona. He has published extensively in the fields of interest. He is member of numerous scientific societies, Treasurer and Education Chair of the International Society for Prenatal Diagnosis (ISPD), past Chair of the Fetal Ultrasound ISPD special interest group, and past Deputy Chair of the Educational Committee of the European Association for Perinatal Medicine (EAPM), President of the Catalan Chapter of Fetal Medicine, and advisor of the Catalan Health Department.
