- From 1977 he relocated to the University of Siena as Associate Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology.
- In 1980 he was awarded as Full Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology and nominated Director of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology at the University of Cagliari.
- From 1^o November 1982 he was nominated Director of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology of the University of Modena
- since 1994 up to 15/02/2012 he become Director of the Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology of the University of Pisa.
- In 1994 he was awarded with the Honoris Causa Laurea by the University of Wroclaw in Poland,
- in 2005 by the University "Ovidius" of Constanta in Romania,
- in May 2007 by the University of Bucharest in Romania and
- in February 2009 by the University of Athens in Greece
- in October 21st 2011 he was entitled Professor Emeritus of the Ministry of Health and Social Development of Russian Federation
