

Short Biography – Anthony J Rutherford

Anthony Rutherford qualified in Medicine at St Mary's hospital London in 1980. He established the Reproductive Medicine Service at Leeds General Infirmary in 1991, and led the development of the Leeds Centre for Reproductive Medicine at Seacroft Hospital, Leeds in 2010, one of the largest clinical facilities in the UK. Research interests include the development of IVF clinical protocols, basic Reproductive Biology and Fertility Preservation in the face of cancer. He was a member of the NICE Fertility Guidelines Committee in 2004, a former Treasurer and Chairman of the British Fertility Society, and currently a Member of the Human Fertility and Embryology Authority.
