

Professor Roy Homburg MB.BS, FRCOG

Professor Homburg has held posts as Professor of Ob/Gyn at Tel Aviv University Medical School, as Professor of Reproductive Medicine at the Free University Medical Centre in Amsterdam, The Netherlands and, presently, as Professor of Reproductive Medicine at Queen Mary Medical School, University of London. Professor Homburg is now Head of Research at the Homerton Fertility Centre, Homerton University Hospital in London and at the Hewitt Fertility Centre in the Liverpool Womens Hospital. As a fertility specialist, Professor Homburg has a worldwide reputation having published 250 research articles and chapters in books and has written or edited seven books. He has been invited to lecture in all five continents at frequent intervals and has won prizes for his research at the British Fertility Society, the American Society of Reproductive Medicine, ESHRE and the Israel Fertility Society (3 times). He has served as an Associate Editor for Human Reproduction and Human Reproduction Update and presently as section editor for Reproductive Biology and Endocrinology. Professor Homburg's main interests are the treatment of infertility, polycystic ovary syndrome, ovulation induction, ovarian stimulation and IVF.
