Antonio La Marca is professor of Obstetrics and Gynaecology at the **Department of Medical and Surgical Sciences for Mother, Child and Adult, University of Modena and Reggio Emilia**, Department of University of Modena and Reggio Emilia, Italy and he is the medical coordinator of Clinica Eugin Modena, Italy. He earned his MD in 1996 from the University of Siena, Italy; he specialized in Obstetrics and Gynecology in 2001 and gained a PhD in 2004.

His clinical activity covers all the field of Reproductive Medicine and Surgery and has taken part in thousands of IVF, laparoscopic and hysteroscopic surgical procedures.

Present scientific interests include: ovarian reserve and endocrinology and pharmacological manipulation of ovarian activity. His “most impacting” articles were on the physiological significance of AMH and AFC, their measurement and clinical utility and on conventional and alternative strategies of ovarian stimulation. He has published a long list of original articles dealing with the prediction of ovarian response in IVF and the personalization of ovarian stimulation protocols. He is author or co-author of more than 160 articles published on peer-reviewed journals and authored many chapters on national and international textbooks. He is a much-requested lecturer and gives around forty invited lectures annually. His current h-index is 38 with more than 6.000 citations. He is involved in several phase 3 and 4 trials as Principal Investigator and is recipient of several research funds competitively assigned. He is active member of many national and international professional and scientific societies and consultant for Italian Ministry of Health for infertility related issues. He is member of the Editorial Board of the journal *Reproductive Biomedicine Online*.
